

2021 Serving the Community

- The Company implements a multi-employment policy to enhance employment opportunities for domestic workers. It uses open recruitment channels and equal employment opportunities to attract and retain outstanding talents. In addition, there are various employment promotion measures such as assisting the society to hire specific targets, such as providing a channel for the unemployed to re-employ. The current employment targets include the disabled, military retired, the unemployed, aborigines, interns, etc.
- Actively promote industry-university cooperation, provide 15 to 30 interns each year, about 14 partner universities and about 3 vocational high schools. It has short-term option in 2-month summer vacation and long-term option of half-year or 1-year. The latter has a salary during the internship and study period, and after graduation, according to the performance during the internship period, it has the opportunity to be preferentially admitted or turned into a full-time employee.
- The Company conducts training courses for aircraft maintenance technicians in the pre-employment training plan, and continues to supplement manpower internally in response to long-term development. Outside the job market, there can also be more learning opportunities for job seekers who are interested in aircraft maintenance, training and employment program can be implemented. After training, those who pass the training can become full-time employees.


